Embassy Brazzaville now has full-service consular operations. American citizens are welcome in the Consular Office Monday through Friday, 7:30-4:00. No appointment is necessary for passport renewal or registration update. However, please be aware that non-immigrant visa interviews take place from 8:00-12:00 and it is recommended that American citizens come in the afternoon to avoid waiting in line to meet with the vice consul.
