Noire requiring consular services such as passport renewal, extra passport pages, or notariats should contact the Consular Section as soon as possible to set up an appointment with the Consular Officer.

A walk in appointment hour has already been scheduled for 5-7 PM on Friday, October 9 at the Hotel Twiga. American citizens who require consular services, need to update their registration, or who would like to meet with the Consular Officer are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity. There is no need to RSVP, but if you are planning to request a specific service such as a passport renewal, please let us know by Wednesday (October 7) so that we can be sure to have the appropriate forms on hand.

Additional appointments with the Consular Officer are available on an as-needed basis on Monday (October 12) morning. Again, please contact us by Wednesday (October 7) to set up an appointment.
